



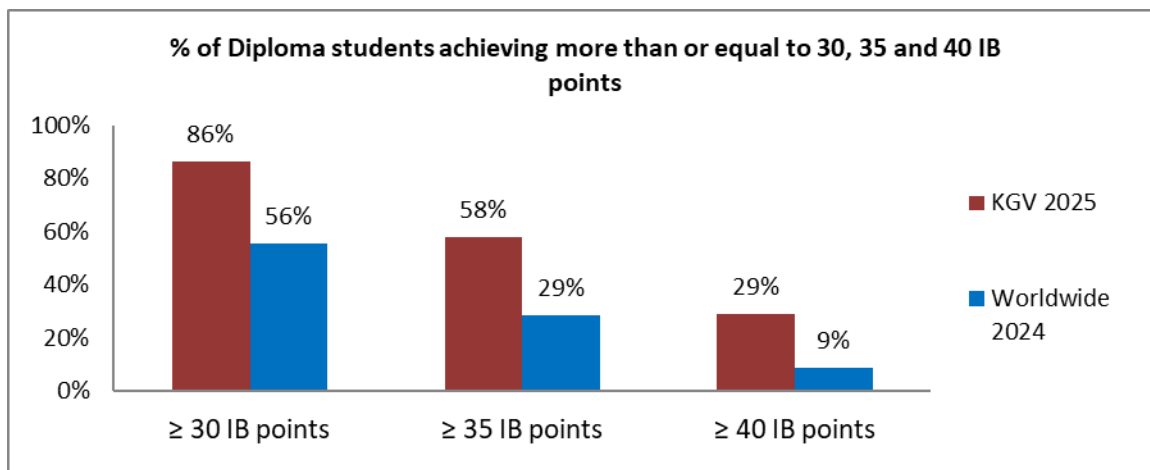
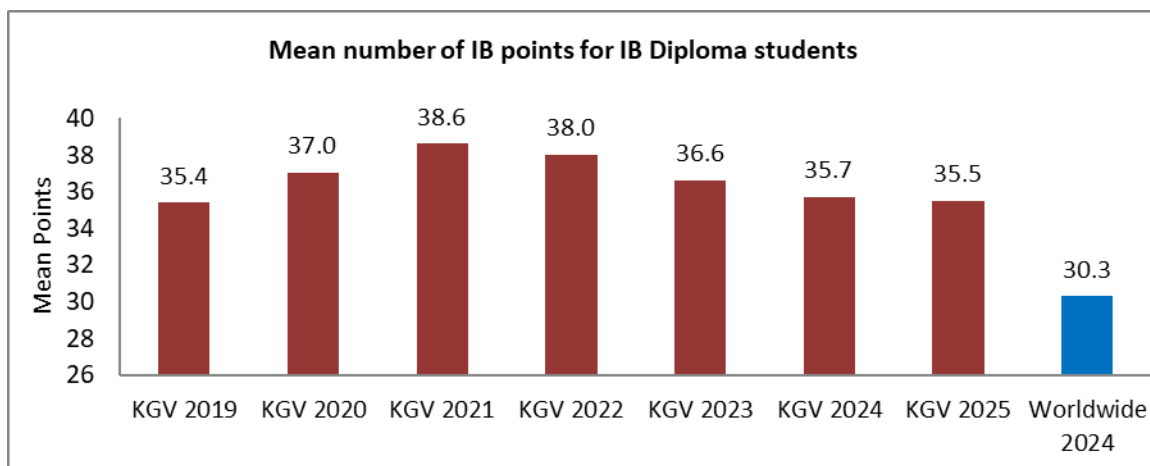
IB Diploma Provisional Results: May 2025 - King George V School

The class of 2025 celebrated an excellent set of IB Diploma scores. A total of 190 students were entered for the full IB Diploma with a 98.4% pass rate. One student achieved the maximum score of 45. All 9 students entered for the Bilingual Diploma passed. The Bilingual Diploma involves studying 2 language subjects as a 'first' language, adding that extra level of difficulty.

KGV had an average IB points score of 35.5 with 86% of students scored at least 30 points out of 45. 58% scored at least 35 points and an impressive 29% of students scored at least 40 points out of 45.

This year also saw our first student ever awarded the IB Career-related Programme.

Congratulations to the class of 2025. This is a truly amazing set of results.

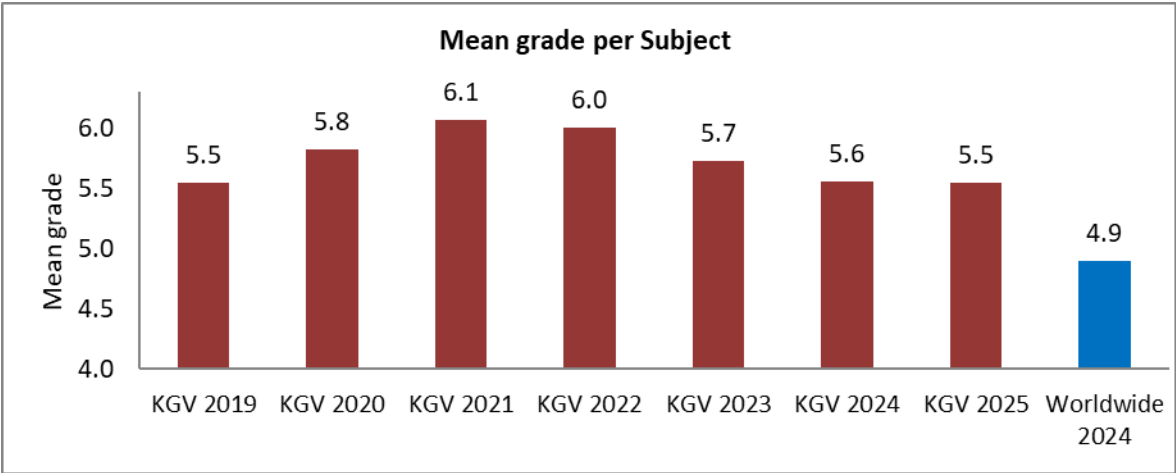
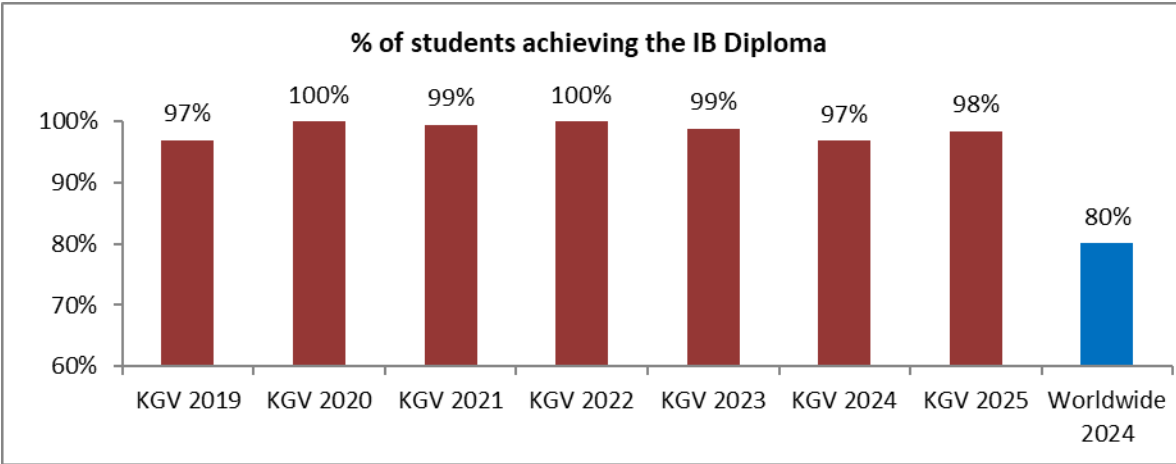
